In The Vineyards – 2009

- 2009 presented certain challenges—from early shatter to late-season rain
- We responded with site-specific techniques that included aggressive leafing, an early thinning protocol and a heavy field sort to select only the most desirable grapes
- Attention to detail in the vineyards, and during harvest and sorting, yielded high quality fruit

Sensory Profile

- The aromas are complex and alluring with layers of sage and dried tobacco leaf wrapped around a chocolate covered cherry core
 - This wine offers a full, textured mouthfeel, with flavors echoing the aromas
 - A long, juicy currant finish is underscored by hints of toasted oak and dried herbs
