In The Vineyards – 2010

- Due to a wet spring and long, mild growing season, the harvest began two weeks later than normal
- A strong heat wave and late rains required us to be extra diligent during harvest, with a focus on fine-tuning and timely picking
- As is often the case in milder years, our 2010 wines are marked by their elegance and balanced natural acidity—qualities we have worked to preserve in the winery

Sensory Profile

- The nose offers classic Cabernet notes of vanilla and black tea with toasty hints of dark chocolate and tobacco leaf
- Though firm on the entry, this wine is rich, ripe and weighty, with lingering flavors of raspberry jam, white pepper, caramel and black tea
