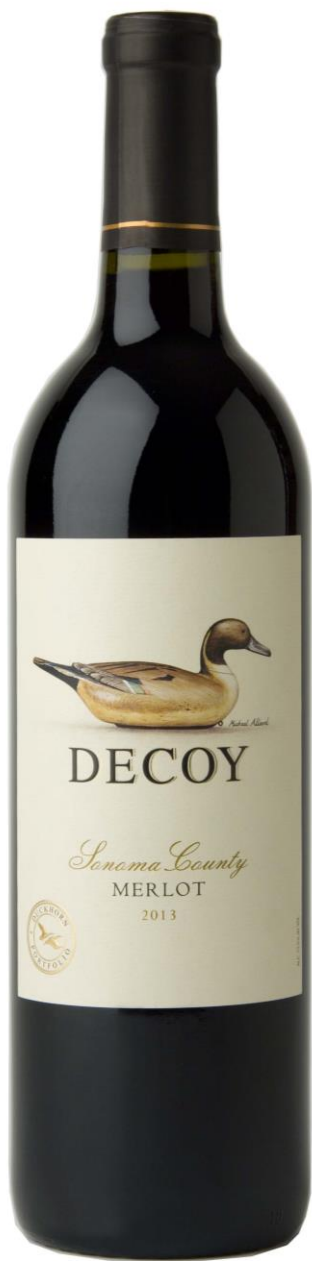




DECOY
