Planted in 2003, and farmed by the Dierberg family, Drum Canyon Vineyard is located on the eastern edge of the famed Sta. Rita Hills winegrowing region, where cool, coastal breezes help to produce a beautifully structured Pinot Noir, with velvety tannins and pure notes of pomegranate, dark cherry and clove.

VINTAGE NOTES

On the Central Coast, cooler summer temperatures with no major heat events ensured a long growing season and abundant hangtime, leading to perfect ripeness and flavor development in the grapes. Lower-than-average yields and smaller berries resulted in incredibly rich and concentrated wines, with our Central Coast reds possessing amazing color, bright acids and deep, lush flavors, and our whites displaying beautiful brightness and sophisticated citrus and stone fruit layers.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Shaped by cooling winds off the Pacific Ocean, the 2019 Drum Canyon Pinot Noir is a luxuriously structured wine with silky tannins and voluptuous layers of dark berry fruit. On both the nose and palate, generous layers of blackberry and blueberry mingle with notes of pomegranate and wild sage, with French oak-inspired hints of vanilla and baking spices adding depth and complexity to the long, velvety finish.
